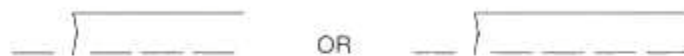


# DIVISION WITH A TWIST

- LEVEL:** Grade 5 and up
- SKILLS:** dividing into three or four-digit numbers
- PLAYERS:** 2 or more players, or  
2 players cooperatively vs. group
- EQUIPMENT:** cards (Ace=1) - 9 + K (K=0), one gameboard per player
- GETTING STARTED:** Each player draws a gameboard as follows:

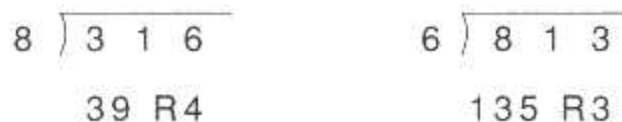
The object of the game is to create the smallest quotient. The deck is placed face down. A card is drawn and placed face up. Each player selects a space on their gameboard and writes the number of this card on it. Three or four more cards are drawn and players proceed to fill in their gameboards. Once all spaces are filled in, players complete the division. The player with the smallest quotient is the winner and scores a point. As players have more experience with this game, they will develop strategies to maximize their chances.

**EXAMPLE:**



First card turned over is an 8  
Second card turned over is a 3

Two or more cards are turned over and completed gameboard could look like this:



Player number one has the least quotient and is the winner for this round. If two (or more) players get the same quotient, then they all score a point for that round. The winner is the player with the most points after a set period of time.
