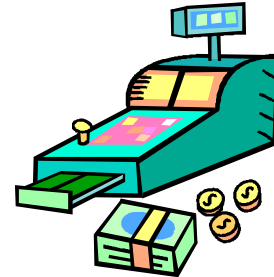


MAKING CHANGE GAME (Univ. of Chicago Everyday Math)

Materials:

- * 2 dice
- * a \$1 bill, 6 quarters, 2 dimes, and 2 nickels for each player
- * Making Change Game Chart (below)



Number of

Players: Two (2) or Three (3)

Directions: There is no money in the bank at the beginning of the game. Players take turns rolling the dice and depositing the corresponding amounts of money in the bank. To determine the amount to deposit, roll the dice and multiply the total number of dots on the dice by 5 cents.

At the beginning of the game, children will be able to count out the exact amounts. Later, they will need to make change from the money in the bank if they don't have the exact amounts. The first player without enough money to put in the bank wins.
